

STADIUM VILLAGE BUSINESS ASSOCIATION ANNUAL DUES STATEMENT

PURPOSE

The Stadium Village Business Association (formerly Concord Business Association) is non-profit, non-partisan organization designed to promote, preserve and improve neighborhood businesses and the surrounding Concord Community by providing a forum for business-to-business networking and information exchange, representation to the City of Indianapolis, State of Indiana, and other organizations as one unified voice on topics such as beautification and development.

BOUNDARIES

The Association is bound by Washington Street to the north, Raymond Street to the south, I-65 to the east and the White River to the west.

MEETINGS

Meetings are held at the Sacred Heart Parish Hall, 1125 S. Meridian St (on the corner of Morris St. and Meridian St.), on the third Wednesday of every month at 8:30 a.m.

MEMBERSHIP TYPES

Business: Any business permanently residing or person(s) owning commercial property within the designated boundaries is eligible for a Business membership in the Association. Business members have voting rights.

- Business 1 – 10 employees \$50
- Business 11 – 25 employees \$100
- Business 26 – 100 employees \$250
- Business 101+ employees \$500

Non-Profit: any organization located within the designated boundaries and registered with the State of Indiana as a nonprofit entity is eligible for a Non-Profit Membership. Non-profit members have voting rights.

- Non-Profit NO CHARGE (please enclosed your certificate for tax purposes)

Associate: Those not meeting either of these criterions may join with the designation of Associate Member. Associate members do not have voting rights.
